Salaries/tuition/benefits for GTIIT grad students

As a new university in China, we are still finding our way concerning many issues, including the appropriate salary scales for grad students.

For the time being, we have set upper bounds on such payments and provide below some guidelines concerning how to determine an appropriate salary. We will allow the funding researcher some say in determining salaries within the upper limits and within her/his budget.

MSc Student

- **Fellowship**: 42,000-54,000 RMB/year (amount will be increased for the period of residence in Technion)
- Waived tuition (worth 15,000 USD per year)
- Subsidized room rental on campus

PhD Student

- **Fellowship**: 60,000-108,000 RMB/year (amount will be increased for period of residence in Technion)
- Waived tuition (worth 15,000 USD per year)
- Subsidized room rental on campus

General comments

- the salary while in China is lower than the fellowship paid to the student when s/he is in Israel
- While GTIIT is not recognized for government contributions to the student's salary, the full salary and some additional costs are to be paid from the researcher's funds (details in budget commitment form)
- As well as academic aspects, also consider the following when discussing salary offers.
 - The school/department from which the student received his previous degree
 - Note that in many universities, PhD students receive less than US\$1,000 /month
 - Cost of living in GTIIT is relatively cheap.
