# Internet and Wireless Access - eduroam



- This is a reciprocal access to this wireless network wherever it is being broadcast around the world. This reciprocal system enables GTIIT students, faculty, and staff to securely access the eduroam wireless network off-campus at more than 5,000 participating locations worldwide.
- Additionally, visitors from any participating eduroam institution can securely connect to the eduroam wireless network while at GTIIT using their own credentials.

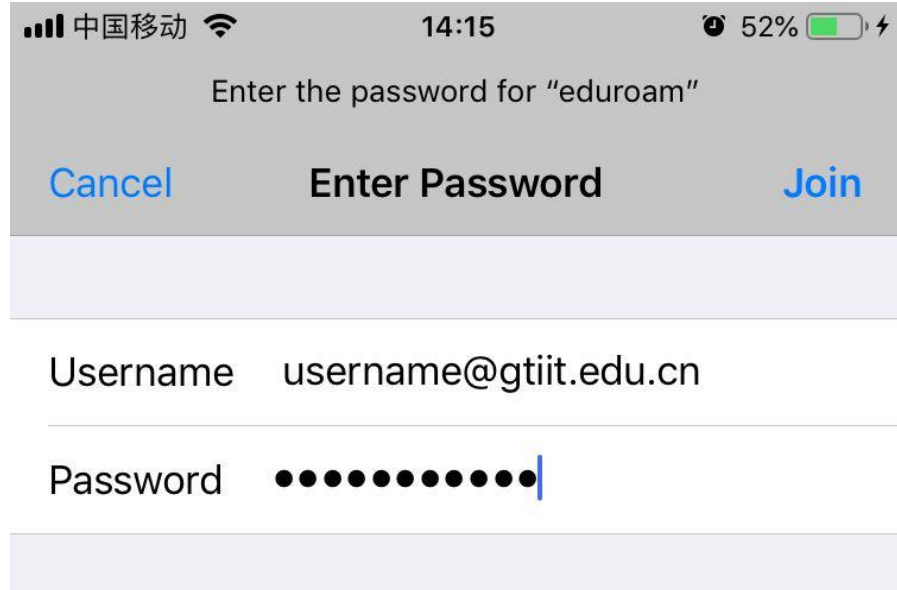
## **It is FREE.**

- **For visitors, login with their own eduroam account and password.**

# Connect to eduroam (iOS device)



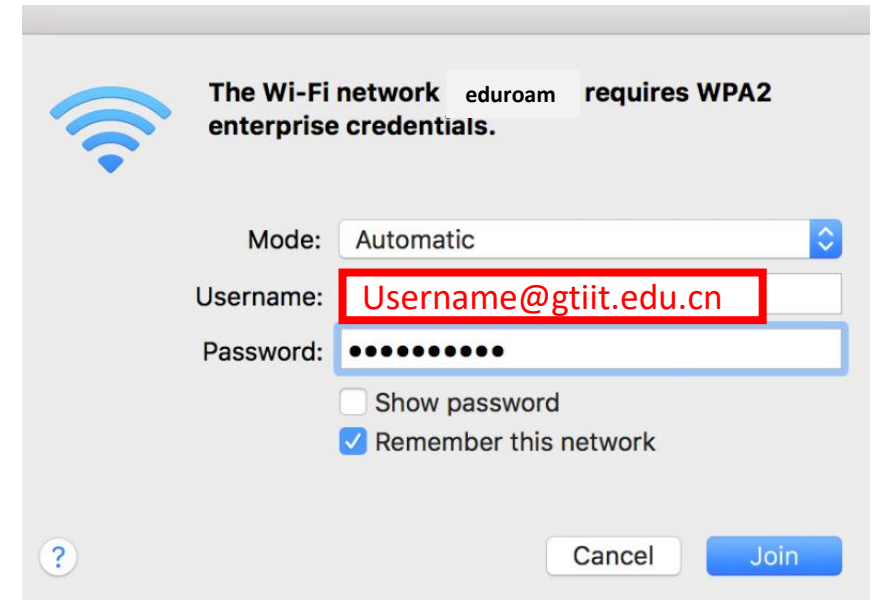
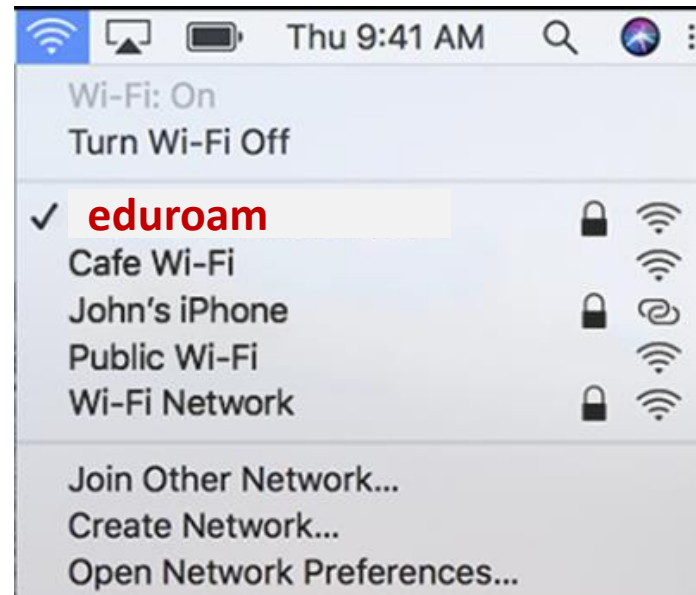
1. Open Settings-> WLAN, Select the eduroam
2. Type in your GTIIT username followed by @gtiit.edu.cn and password
3. Click 'Join'
4. Click Trust of the Certification



# Connect to eduroam (Mac OS)



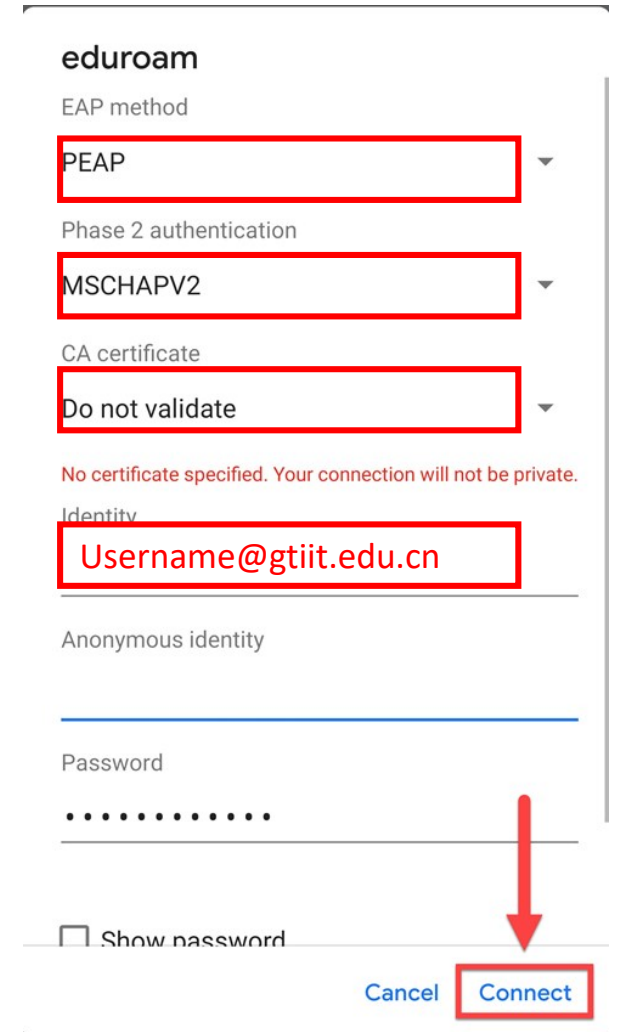
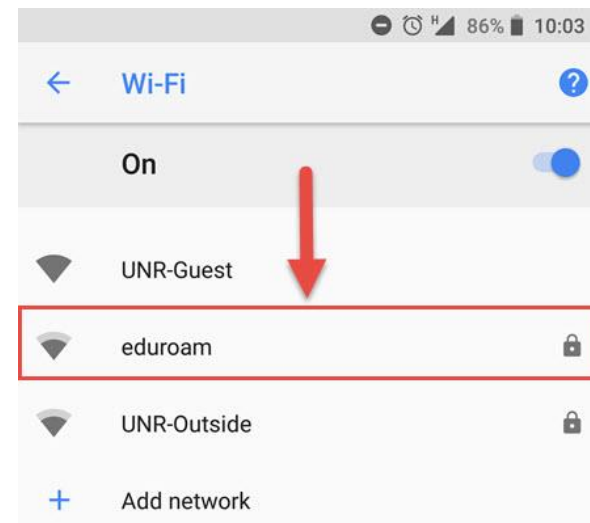
1. Click the wireless network **eduroam**
2. Type in your GTIIT username followed by `@gtiit.edu.cn` and password
3. Click 'Join'
4. Verify the Certification - Make sure the Certificates server name is 'gtiit.edu.cn'.
5. Click 'Continue'.



# Connect to eduroam (Android)



1. Select the wireless network **eduroam**
2. Complete the connection configuration  
**EAP=PEAP,Phase2=MSCHAPV2**
3. Select Do not validate at CA certificate.
4. Type in **your GTIIT username followed by @gtiit.edu.cn** and password
5. Click 'Connect'.



# Connect to GTIIT-SEC (Windows 10)



Windows10

1. Click the wireless network icon on the taskbar.
2. Click the wireless network **eduroam**.
3. Click Connect.
4. Type in your **GTIIT** email address followed by **@gtiit.edu.cn** & password
5. Click 'OK'.
